Revolution Camp 2026 will be happening on 27th March – 29th March (Friday - Sunday). We are graciously being hosted in a lovely home. The address is: Plot 25A Melody Hartbeespoort Dam

The convoy will leave from Northpoint City Church (195 Bellairs Drive, North Riding) at 15:00 on Friday the 27th of March. We will return at 12:00 on Sunday the 29th of March. If campers are not present for the departure times, they will be left behind and will be the parents'/guardians' responsibility for travel.

To save cost this year, we have not hired transportation. As youth leaders, we will take some of the group. However, we do require a few parents to help. Please contact Brad if you are able to assist with lifts to or from the venue.

Items to bring:

- Bible, pen and notepad
- The house is well-sized with plenty of bathrooms to be allocated. We will be staying in their patio and potentially in a few tents. Please bring an inflatable bed, duvet/sleeping bag and pillow.
- Clothes for 3 days and 2 nights
- At least 1 pair of tekkies, closed shoes, slops and socks
- An additional set of clothes and a pair of closed shoes which may get wet and dirty
- Hats and Caps!
- Swimming costume
- Towels
- Plastic plate, bowl and cup/mug (something to hold hot drinks too)
- Knife, fork and spoon
- Sponge and dish cloth
- Water bottle
- Torch
- Necessary hygiene products
- **Mosquito repellent and sunscreen**
- Any necessary and precautionary medication that you may need.

Medication:

Prescription medication will be collected at the beginning of camp. A register of medication and dosage requirements will be recorded and kept in a secure place. We do this to ensure that the medication is not lost and kept securely.



Terms and Conditions of Appropriate behaviour:

We are excited to have an awesome weekend with all those joining and are expecting good times of worship and fellowship. We aim to ensure that the camp is safe and secure for teens to enjoy. For this reason, we will set out certain boundaries that are to be respected, to prevent any distracting or disruptive behaviours during the weekend.

The following inappropriate behaviours will not be tolerated, and we will contact the parents/guardians of the guilty parties to come fetch the camper immediately.

- Any sexual activities or interaction.
- Any use of alcohol or illegal substances.
- Abuse of the camp facilities.
- If a camper is officially warned and instructed to stop behaviours that endanger themselves or others and they disregard the instructions.
